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
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# Have you taken a walk around the Patient-Centered Medical NEIGHBORHOOD?

- Community-located programs: Early Intervention local agencies, Schools, Autism Resource Centers, Special Aftercare programs and summer programs




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


#### Early Childhood and Youth Referrals for:

- Language (expressive and/or receptive) delays
  - Other developmental concerns/delays
- · Atypical behaviors in toddlers/preschoolers/school age youth
  - Failed developmental SWYC screens +/= POSI
  - Teacher classroom behavior or learning concerns •

There is currently a 9 to 24 month waiting period for BMC Developmental/Behavioral Pediatrics There is no current referral to Pediatric/Youth Neuropsychologists who take MassHealth outside of DCF/DYS


Create your own Care Maps and Workflows after Positive Developmental Screens or Parental Concerns

# Why is Understanding Part B and Part C and how they are administered important?

- Know the WHO, WHAT, WHEN, WHY, HOW
- Understand what your options are at different points in the child's developmental timeline
- Understand when the pediatric team needs to be more involved for getting services "in time".


