2026 Vaccine Education Webinar Series Information

The goal of the Vaccine Education Webinar Series is to improve Massachusetts' immunization rates across the lifespan. This is accomplished through presentation of one-hour didactic immunization update webinars 4 to 6 times a year. The webinars are developed specifically for healthcare professionals who administer immunizations to children, adolescents, and adults. Webinar content is focused on current immunization recommendations, improvement on vaccine knowledge and confidence, strategies for optimal vaccine delivery and administration, and identifying and eliminating barriers to immunization.

Target Audience

The target audience includes healthcare professionals who provide immunizations in Massachusetts, including MCAAP members, physicians, nurse practitioners, nurses, physician assistants, medical assistants, public health workers, community health center staff, pharmacists and office staff who work in pediatric and adult health care settings.
